Currently 16 evangelists (male and female), 6 teachers, and almost 100 children are being sponsored through IREF(UK), generating a regular income of over £22,000 per year.

All donations can benefit from the Government's Gift Aid scheme. Please contact the Honorary Treasurer for further details and the relevant forms to complete.

Since IREF(UK) was founded in 1996, over £370,000 has been raised to sponsor children (£140,000), Pastor/Evangelists (£90,000), and various other needs (£140,000). These other needs have included: church building projects, a contribution towards the building costs for IREF's Degree College, the provision of sick rooms at the Lydia Children's Home in Repalle, the support of full-time nurses, the start-up costs for several Child Development Centres, the purchase of medicines, toothbrushes, uniforms and sports equipment for IREF's schools, disaster relief supplies, and investment in income generation projects.

We are keen to make the work of IREF as widely known as possible and would ask for your help in encouraging others to be supportive through their prayers, sponsorship and/or donations.

How your gifts can help IREF

£2.50	buys a Telegu Bible for distribution to new Christians (5,000 needed a year)
£3	enables a pastor or evangelist to attend a training day for 1,000 church leaders
£9	buys a School Uniform for the many children in IREF's care (2,000 needed)
£45	buys a sewing machine for a family to support itself for a year
£60	buys a Bicycle for use by evangelists to help them travel from village to village
£60	buys Musical instruments for use by evangelists
£100	supports a child in a Child Development Centre for a year

£7,500	pays for a Concrete/Brick Village Church Building to provide a permanent <i>meeting place for believers and safe shelter during storms</i>
