The India Rural Evangelical Fellowship is an indigenous Indian Christian organisation working in the state of Andhra Pradesh. It has been working amongst the rural poor for almost 60 years, since its formation in 1950. As well as its evangelistic and church planting work, IREF runs several schools, colleges and children's homes. It is also involved in many humanitarian relief projects, including the provision of clean drinking water for remote villages and house-building projects for tsunami victims.
